Procedure for transfer of name of an Advocate from the Rolls of the State Bar Council to the Rolls of another State Bar Council – reg.

The authority to transfer the name of an Advocate from the Rolls of the State Bar Council where he was enrolled, to the Rolls of another State Bar Council vests with the Bar Council of India, New Delhi.

The Application for transfer has to be made to the Bar Council of India under Section 18 of the Advocates Act 1961, in the prescribed form.

If you enrolled in a State Bar Council other than ours, you are advised to contact your State Bar Council.

But if you are enrolled in our Bar Council, you are requested to inform us your Rolls no. & Date of Enrolment and send to us the following:

- 1) a) a Crossed Demand Draft for Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) towards no objection certificate and a sum of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) towards rolls certificate in favour of "The secretary, Bar Council of Tamil Nadu, Chennai" and a sum of Rs. 850/-(Rupees eight hundred and fifty only) towards processing of transfer application.
- b) Self Addressed stamped envelope for Rs. 45/- for transmitting the certificates.
- c) Xerox copy of enrolment certificate.
- 2) On receipt of which we shall consider your request and let you have the undermentioned documents:
 - a) Our No objection certificate for releasing your name from the Rolls of our Bar Council.
 - b) Certified copy of the entry of your name in our Rolls.
- 3) With these documents and a remittance of Rs. 750/- by Demand Draft/ Money Order you may apply directly to "The Secretary, Bar Council of India, 21, Rouse Avenue, Institutional Area, New Delhi 110 002" for transfer of your name from our Bar Council to the State Bar Council of your choice.
